

We The Leaders Foundation volunteers conducted a eregistration camp for e-SHRAM website in WTLF Velayuthampalayam Center.

Agriculture and daily wage labours actively participated and about 35 villagers got their ID cards immediately after the registration was complete.

Most of the women crowd in the village also got their registration done in the e-SHRAM website.

The event had an active participation and about 50 villagers got their ID cards immediately after the registration was complete.

We The Leaders Foundation volunteers continued to identify place to assist and educate people about the central government schemes and their benefits. Similarly, our volunteers came across people from all walks of life and organised a camp in Ellamedu and Elavanur, areas located in central part of Aravakurichi.

People in these areas are daily wage labours working in textile companies, bus body building companies, garment companies, agricultural farm works etc., people those who were eligible for registering to e-SHRAM schemes got registered and received ID cards.

About 65 participants registered during the 2 days camp.

Velayuthampalayam and Mel Orathai are places for agriculture and have more labours who work in agriculture farms. WLTF volunteers educated the labours about the central government schemes like e-SHRAM and Ayushman Bharath Medical Insurance Schemes etc., Volunteers also managed to cover the rural parts of Velayuthampalayam spreading awareness about the schemes.

Since all these people are eligible for this central government scheme we first spoke to them on these schemes and discussed with them regarding the importance an need to get registered on this scheme.


So people came to these camps to get them registered in e-SHRAM scheme and we had around 45 people registered for these scheme in this camp.

Farmers Survey - Field Work at S.Thottampatti and Valayanur

WTLF volunteers had conducted a field survey visiting places of S.Thottampatti and Valayanur. During the activity, the volunteers have managed to collect datas of farmers in the village who are involved in farming activities on daily bases.

Details like the type of land they own(cultivable or non cultivable), source of water, farming equipments they own, No.of mammals(cows & goats) etc.,

Volunteers also understood from the villagers about the ground water depletion, decrease in average rainfall and lack of proper guidance for the practising farming effectively.

Volunteers have discussed about the appropriate solution of inviting expertise on field through We The Leaders Foundation and taking their guidance in order to maintain the best practise and increase greenery in the surrounding areas.


Volunteers Meet with the Traditional Organic Farmer

On 24.01.2022 we met Mr.Sivanathan a traditional organic farmer from Ayikoundampalayam from Velayandipatti panchayat. He had practiced the traditional method of farming from our very famous G.Nammalvar who is one among the pioneers in bringing back the traditional way of farming. He is now following the traditional way to grow the traditional rice varieties like Karuppukavuni, Mappilaisamba, Kudhiraivaali and etc.,

He is using vermicompost, Panchakavya and other organic composts in his land. As a result he has brought chemical free grains.


Farmers Survey - Field Work at Inanganur, Aravakurichi (Visit 2)



During the first visit to Inanganur village for the improvement of the village; WTLF volunteers had made a study about the whole of Inanganur village. Volunteers collected datas of villagers and categorised them accordingly.

Employment and education for single parent children and students under poverty were given prime importance. The details on farming practice and water resources in these areas were also documented.

Awareness Program - Women Safety and Entrepreneurship

WTLF conducted an awareness program on women's safety and entrepreneurship to villagers in Inanganur. Volunteers came across that these villagers travel to area of Karur as daily wagers and for some agro-based works who are not aware of the wide range of opportunities available for them in the society. Considering the skills and interest level of each individuals and manufacturers of products like banana fibre, maple leaves, jute etc., were made aware of the government schemes and available loan faciliteis for starting up their own businesses.

They were also given some ideas about the latest products and trend in the market with the right contact for getting better visibility and sales. Volunteers also discussed about the ideas of ecommerce and other ways to market and sell their products through various offline and online modes.

Akilandapuram is a land of low water availability and it has red soil which is suitable for Senganthal Poo (Gloriosa Superba) which is locally called kanvali cultivation. And most of this land mainly depends on rain water and well water. Many of their generic needs and issues were documented.


About 65 people from the village participated in the open workshop. For participants who weren't aware about these schemes received proper explainations and guidance from our volunteers.


