

WTLF Volunteers Assisting the Physically Challenged: Facilitating Government Aid

We The Leaders Foundation strives to serve and support individuals with disabilities, ensuring they have access to the necessary government aids and welfare schemes. Our volunteers received a phone call from a family residing in Chinnadharapuram, seeking assistance in obtaining a Disability Certificate for their special needs child. Unaware of the proper procedures, they turned to our foundation for guidance. Understanding their plight, our team promptly visited their home, collected the required information, and initiated the necessary steps to secure the certificate.

To facilitate the registration process, WTLF volunteers accompanied the family to the Collector Office in Karur and met with the Officer for the Disabled Person Welfare Department and the E-District Manager.

After completing the necessary formalities, the details of the special needs child were entered into the registration form including capturing eye marks and fingerprints for identification purposes. The family was provided with a receipt as proof of application submission. These measures were taken to initiate the official documentation process, marking the first step towards obtaining the Disability Certificate.




