Empowering Villagers through Awareness Camp and Registration Drive in Thokkupatti

We The Leaders Foundation, in collaboration with local authorities, organized an Awareness Camp and Registration Drive to enlighten villagers about central government schemes like Atal Pension Yojana (APY) and Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana (SSY) in the rural village of Karungal Puliyampatti in Thokkupatti panchayat.

The aim of the camp was to educate and empower villagers by providing detailed information about these schemes and facilitating their registration for long-term benefits.

In addition to conducting the Awareness Camp, We The Leaders Foundation also engaged with local authorities to strengthen the reach and impact of the initiative. 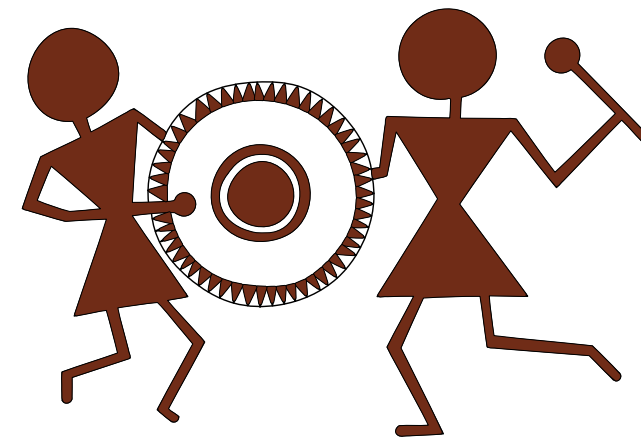

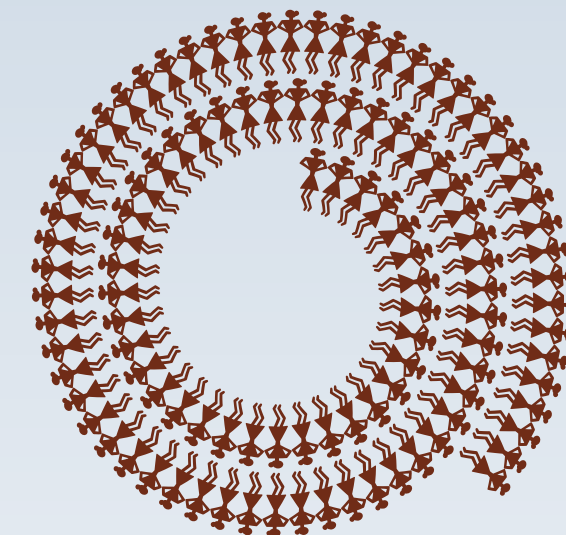

Empowering the Elderly: Assisting Srirangan with National Old Age Pension Scheme Enrollment

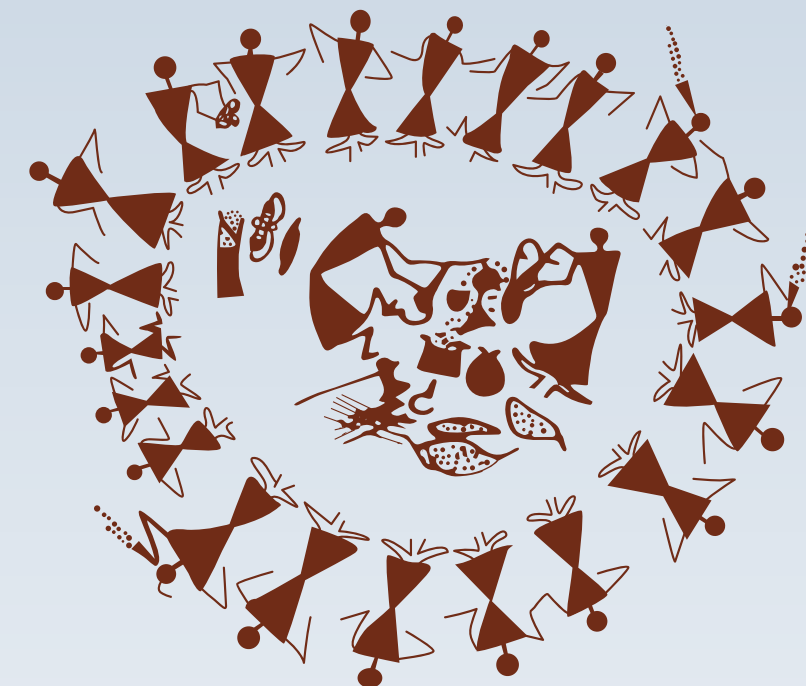

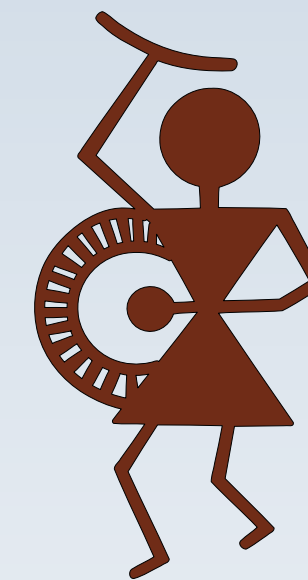
The tournament's final day witnessed an impressive prize distribution ceremony attended by esteemed guests:

Inner Harmony: Celebrating International Yoga Day

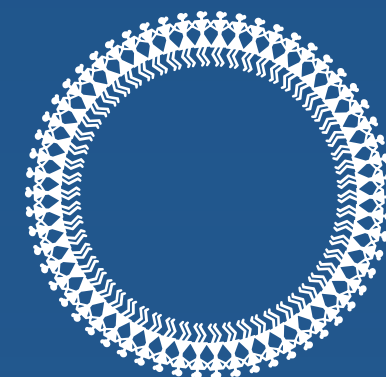

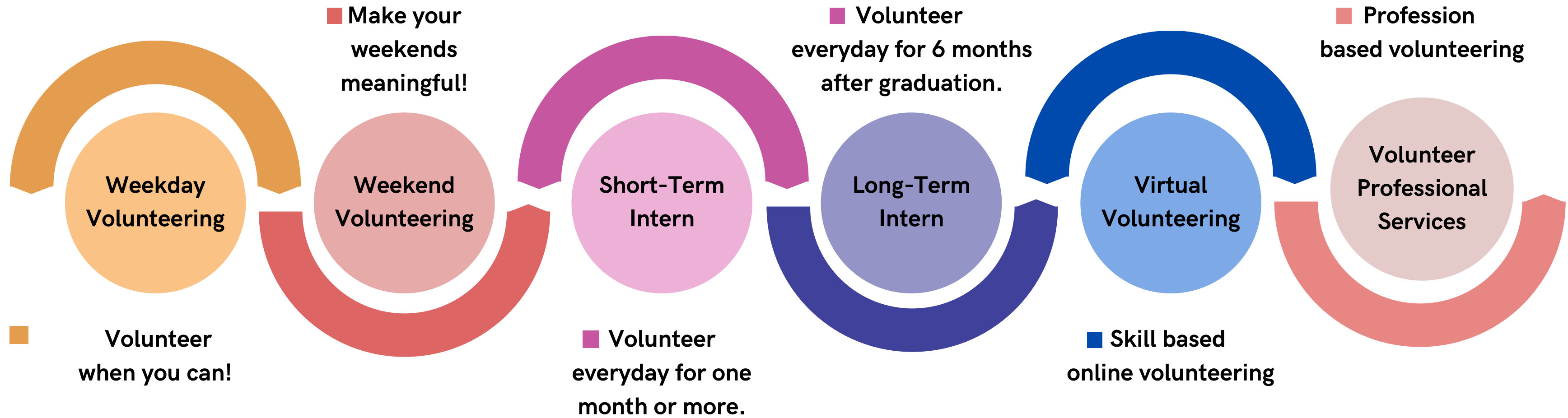

Long Term Intern

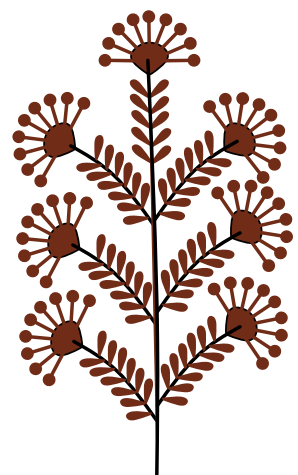
